SCENE: - THE PILLOW FIGHT

Two young people (10-14 yrs) were sitting astride a fence (or suspended plank boom). Both are equipped with a pillow or bag of hay or similar. The two take a swing at one another simultaneously.

Patient 1

Was struck on the back of the head as he turned away causing whiplash to the neck and falls to the ground on his outstretched right hand causing a fracture (closed) to the lower arm near the wrist.

Patient 2

The swinging momentum causes him to lose his balance and fall off - landing on his left shoulder causing a fractured collar bone and a graze to the left side of his forehead.
