INDIVIDUAL SCENARIO

This year, St. John Ambulance is celebrating 100 years of service in Ontario. Part of the celebrations, includes parades similar to the one that you are presently watching on this sunny Autumn day (10°C./50°F.). A tractor that is pulling one of the parade floats stalls it's engine. One of the spectators steps forward and puts their hands in the engine compartment in an effort to help restart the engine. The engine unexpectedly starts up again and the spectator jumps back screaming and falls to the ground where you find him/her.

Good luck! You have 15 minutes to complete the scenario.

N.B.

There will be an announcement of time at the 5 minute, 10 minute, and final 2 minutes points of the scenario.

INDIVIDUAL SCENARIO

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INJURIES

- Unconscious (fainted)-regains consciousness at the 10 minute mark of scenario.
- Usual appearance of shock in the facial area.
- Amputated right hand (severed).
- Closed fracture of right ankle (inside ankle).

CASUALTY PROMPTS

- unconscious for the first 10 minutes of scenario (no response to pain, and regains consciousness at 10 minute announcement).
- pain in right wrist (from missing hand, and reacts loudly to pain once conscious).
- pain in right ankle (from fracture, and reacts loudly to pain once conscious).

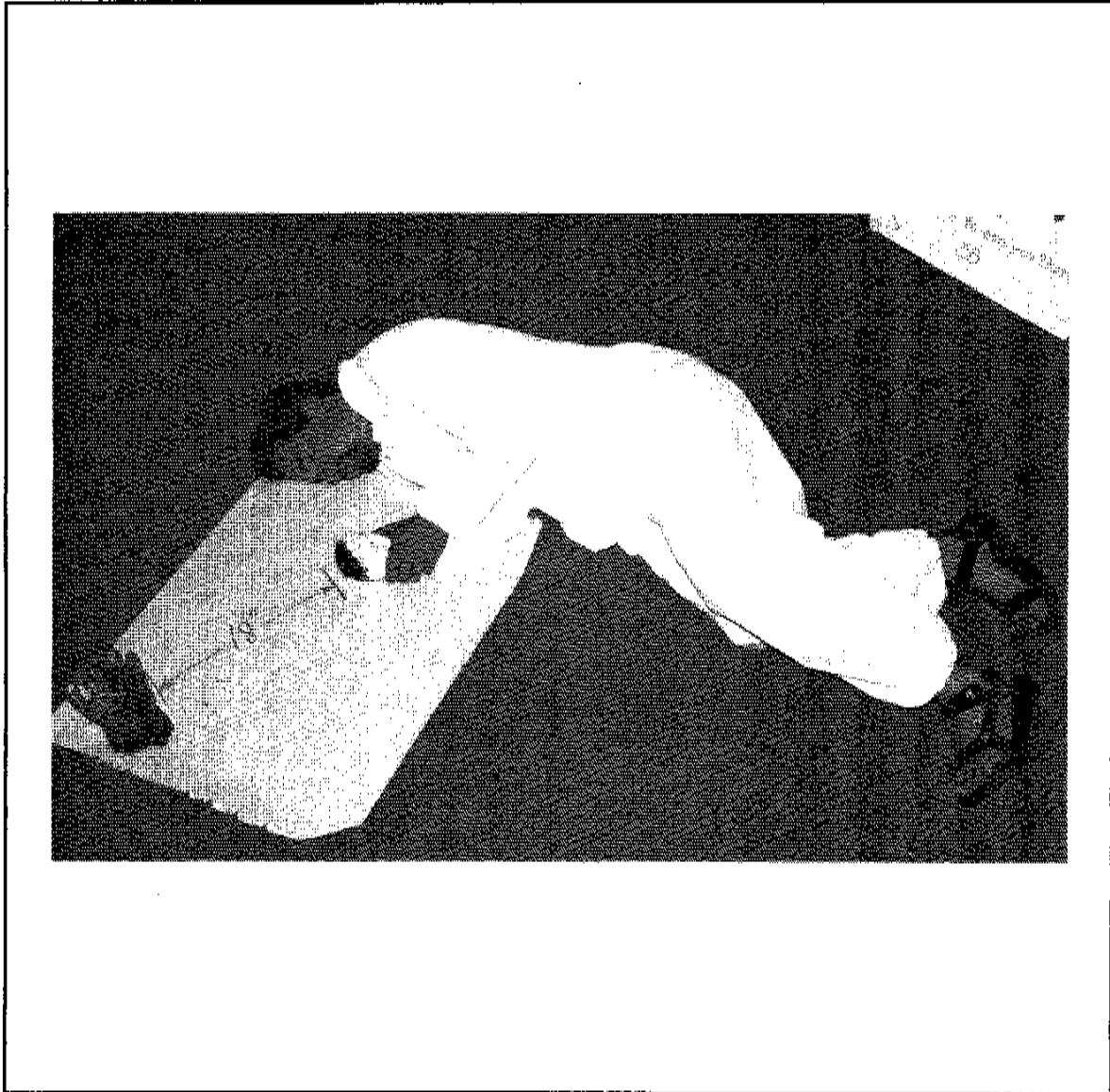
PROPS

- already prepared severed right hand.
- during scenario, audio of parade route noise from marching bands and a crowd.
- slides of a parade (floats, bands, clowns, etc.).
