JUDGE'S COPY OF SCENARIO INDIVIDUAL SCENARIO

Keeping with the season, there is a Halloween party going on here at the hotel. You hear a scream and when you investigate you discover an individual laying on the floor.

Good luck! You have 15 minutes to complete the scenario.

N.B.

There will be an announcement of time at the 5 minute, and again at the final 2 minutes.

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INJURIES

- Appearance of shock in the facial area.
- Deep incision between thumb and forefinger and extending across palm of right hand. deep enough to result in cut tendons.
- Abdominal knife cut, diagonal cut, diagonally across abdomen, (down and out), medial to distal, 5 cm right of the umbilicus, 12 cm long, with bowel protruding, (only minor bleeding).
- dislocated left shoulder, dislocated in fall and fixed in raised position found, unable to be moved.

CASUALTY PROMPTS

- casualty at Halloween party, dressed as a space person, was knifed in a fight.
- Conscious throughout the scenario.
- pain in abdomen (reacts loudly to pain).
- pain in right hand (from knife incision, reacts loudly to pain).
- pain in left shoulder (from dislocation from fall)
- IF ASKED: has an allergy to peanuts.
- IF ASKED, have taken NO medications.
- IF ASKED, have no medical history.
- IF ASKED, have no Medical Alert.
- IF ASKED, ate last meal about 2 hours ago.

PROPS

- knife laying on floor.
- abdominal evisceration (bowel protruding).
- wearing Tyvec coveralls with Tyvec hood
- wearing cotton gloves on both hands, cut for incision wound.
