2. All forms of voluntary service for the Cadet Special Service Shield must be carefully recorded in the Divisional or Cadet Duty Register, properly certified by the individual responsible for the duty, and by the Division Superintendent.
3. Probationary members and St. John Juniors are not eligible for these awards.
4. The Special Service Shield **will not** be awarded to Crusaders to recognize service performed subsequent to their 16th birthday. General Regulation 7.19 refers.
