SUBJECT:

COLLECTOR

OBJECTIVE(S)

To promote an interest in serious collecting.

To learn to mount/display a collection (or part of one).

To encourage public speaking by presenting the collection to a group of peers.

PREREQUISITES

A minimum period of involvement of *12 months* before applying for the proficiency certificate.

INSTRUCTORS/EVALUATORS

- A member of the community or the Brigade with knowledge/experience of the specific collection or collecting generally.

REFERENCES AND MATERIALS

1. Collectors' clubs or groups
2. Individual collectors
3. Book stores, hobby/card shops
4. Libraries
5. Internet

CONTENT

Candidates must have:

1. collected an acceptable number of items (the number would depend on the type of collection).
2. accumulated some information about the collected items, preferably in print form.

DURATION

Minimum of 12 months collection period.

CERTIFICATION

The candidate must:

- have personally collected 50% of the collection by means other than purchase, ie. trading, searching, gifts;
- display at least part of the collection for viewing;
- present the collection or part of it to a group of peers, e.g. Division, highlighting some items and explain why they're special.
