### APPLICATION TO HOLD ST. JOHN AMBULANCE YOUTH AND ADULT CAMPS

The number of St. John Ambulance Camps held in Ontario has continued to grow over the years and has expanded to include both youth and adult oriented camping experiences.

To ensure safe and healthy camping experiences, the following procedures must be adhered to:

- a. An APPLICATION TO HOLD A ST. JOHN AMBULANCE CAMP (Youth and/or Adult) shall be used to apply for permission to conduct all St. John Ambulance Camps whether they are oriented to youth or adult participants. No St. John Ambulance Camp shall be held without prior Provincial Headquarters approval.
- b. All participants (staff) in positions of trust or authority at the camp must be listed on the APPLICATION TO HOLD A ST. JOHN AMBULANCE CAMP and must comply with St. John Ambulance's screening policies, including those related to Police Record Checks.

The Provincial Commissioner or his/her designate will approve all St. John Ambulance Camps (youth or adult).
